Note: We understand that sometimes circumstances beyond your control may prevent you making your scheduled appointment (illness, severe weather, transportation problems,... etc.) If you know that you cannot make this appointment, please call to reschedule with more than 24 hours notice or it will be considered a 'no-show' visit. No-Shows without a reasonable excuse will be charged an additional \$15.00 that will not be covered by insurance.

Please bring the following information with you

- Identification such as an Official Photo ID or Driver's license (note: A new Federal law requires us to verify your identity)
- Your current Insurance Card (including any secondary insurance)
- Your Insurance co-payment (which will be collected at check-in)
- A list of current medicines, allergies & eye procedures with dates

What do you need to know about the visit

- Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your appointment
- Filling out your forms beforehand will make your check-in faster
- Your thorough examination and testing may last up to 2 hours
- If you are diabetic, eat before you come and bring a snack.
- You will need a driver to take you home after being dilated
- Bringing sunglasses will make the return home more comfortable
- If you have appointed someone with Power of Attorney, we will need a copy of that document



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Welcome to our practice. Erie Retinal Surgery has been serving the retinal needs of the Northwest PA region since 1984. We strive to make our retinal evaluation and treatment as efficient and easy as possible, but you can expect to be here for one to two hours for an initial evaluation (or re-evaluation and treatment on the same day). Because dilating drops usually need to be used and these may make driving somewhat difficult, we request that patients have a driver and sunglasses when coming to our office. Patients with retinal emergencies may be seen on short notice and cause schedule changes. If the appointment is in enough of an advance, we will send an information packet to new patients. We appreciate a list of all your medications and dietary supplements (including vitamins and over-the-counter medications). It is helpful to know your medical history and the dates of any eye procedures. Please bring your insurance cards and a photo ID with you for verification.

Directions to Erie Retinal Surgery Office and Hamot Surgery Center:

From Interstate 79 (North To Erie):

1. Travel north on I-79, continue straight onto Bayfront Hwy
2. At State Street, turn right and travel up (south) on State to 4th
3. Turn right (west) on 4th St., go ½ block; enter parking lot on right

From Interstate 90 (East or West to Erie):

- You can take Interstate 90 to Interstate 79 North and follow the above directions or . . .
1. Take Peach Street Exit (heading North toward Erie, PA)
 2. Continue (north) on Peach to 4th St. Turn right (east) on 4th St and go ½ block, enter parking lot on left side
